<u>O R D E R</u>

Under Note to Rule 33 (c) Part I, Kerala Service Rules it is stated that the appointing authority should in each case certify that the officer would have actually continued to officiate in the post but for his proceeding on leave and the period of leave will count for increments only to the extent if is covered by the certificate.

2. A question has been raised whether the aforesaid certificate of continued affiliation can be issued by the leave sanctioning authority instead of by the appointing authority where no officiating arrangements is made in the leave vacancy and where the officer returns to the same post after the expiry of leave

3. Government are pleased to order that in cases of the kind referred to in para 2 above the certificate may be issued by the authority sanctioning the leave at the time of sanction.

4. Necessary amendments will be made to the Note to Rule 33 (c) in the course.
