ORDER

In supersession of the orders issued in the G.O read above, Government are pleased to delegate the following powers to the officers of the Forest Department in the matter of granting extensions to contracts for supply and sale of timber from forests, in all cases, where the agreements provide for extensions of the period of contract with penalty.

- 1. Divl. Forest Officers for a period of one month
- 2. Conservators of Forests for a period of three months including the extension sanctioned by the Divl. Forest Officers.
- 3. Chief Conservator of Forests for a period of six months including the extension sanctioned by the subordinate officers.

In all cases where the agreement provided for extension, but no penalty is provided, sanction be obtained from Government in the Administrative Department. The Chief Conservator of Forests is informed that hereafter in all cases fo agreements, penalty clauses should also be included if extension of th period of contract is contemplated.
