# Delegating of Powers to Heads of Departments Enhancement of-Orders Issued

#### ORDER

In the G.O read as Ist paper above Government had delegated certain financial and administrative powers to the Heads of Departments and Administrative Departments of Secretariat. In partial modification of rule 4 and 5 of "II Delegation of Financial Powers" contained in the G.O cited Government delegate the following powers to all Heads of Departments in respect of the local purchase of stationary and the sanctioning of rent private buildings.

- 1. Local purchase of stationery-The monetary limit for local purchase of stationary articles is raised from Rs. 100 to Rs. (50 at a time and subject to maximum of Rs. 1500 per annum)
- 2. Rent of private building- The monetary limit of the rent of private buildings is raised from Rs. 200 to Rs. 300 per month in each case, other condition now applicable remarking the time.
