ORDER

In the G.O. read above, Government have amended General Rule 10 of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules 1958, further raising the upper age limit prescribed in the Special Rules as raised by the Public Service (Raising upper age limit for appointment) Rules 1972, by three years in the case of Land Verification Volunteers who were recruited during the year 1973-74 under the Half-a-million jobs programme and were subsequently retrenched.

2. Government are now pleased to order that the age relaxation granted to the former Land Verification Volunteers in the G.O.read as above, will also apply in respect of posts for which special Rules have not been issued so far, and direct recruitment is made on the basis of age qualification tec. Prescribed in executive orders.

3. This order will be deemed to have come into force with effect on and from the 13th June 1977.
