ORDER

The Government of India, in their Office Memorandum read, as first paper above, had communicated their decision to review the existing form of Service Book of Central Government employees and forward specimen copy of the revised Service Book. After examining the proposal for revision of the Service Book of State Government employees in the light of the revised form of Service Book of the Central Government employees in consultation with the Accountant- General, the Government are pleased to revise the existing form of Service Book as in the form appended.

- 2. The revised form will be applicable only to new entrants in Government service and will be used even in their case only when the existing stock of the Service Book is exhausted. In the case of Government servants already in service the new Service Book may be used when the page in the existing book are finished and the existing stock is exhausted and in that case the existing entries need not be -written in the new form.
- Amendments to the rules in Kerala Service Rules will issue separately. 3.
