PUBLIC SERVICES – RECURITMENT TO GOVERNMENT SERVICE-CONCESSIONS TO THE DEPENDENTS OF DEFENCE PERSONNEL GREF AND BSF PERSONNEL LILLED/MISSING/DISABLED IN ACTION ETC. – CONSOLIDATED ORDERS ISSUED

## **ORDER**

Government have granted various concessions to the dependents of Defence personnel killed/disabled/missing in action. Some of the concessions have been extended to the dependents of personnel of GREF/BSF also. In order to achieve uniformity and to avoid ambiguity in the matter of various concessions to different categories, Government hereby issue the following orders in super session of all the orders on the subject:-

The concessions under this order shall be applicable to the following categories involved in 1947-48 Kishmir Conflict and Goa and Hyderabad Operations, 1962 Chinese Aggression, 1983 and 1971 Indo-Pak Wars:-

- (i) Dependents of Defence GREF/BSF Personnel:-
  - (a) Killed/missing/disabled in action and since discharged owing to such disability and those killed in action against Nags hostiles.
  - (b) Killed/missing/disabled and discharged from service due to such disability as result of clash with hostile foreign nationals on Jammu & Kashmir ceasefire line or the Chinese line of actual control in NEFA and Ladakh or on/across the border of India with foreign counties.
  - (c) Died or permanently disabled while serving in operations areas due to bunker collapse/motor accident/high altitude/adverse climatic or terrain conditions or due to explosion of mine during mine clearing operations.
- (ii) Defence, GREF and BSF Personnel:
  - (a) Disabled in action
  - (b) Disabled while serving in the operational area due to high altitude or adverse climatic or terrain conditions or due to explosion of mine during mine clearing operations.
  - (c) Disabled as a result of clash with hostile foreign nationals on Jammu and Kashmir ceasefire line or the Chinese line of actual control in NEFA and Ladakh or on/across the border of India with foreign countries.
- 2. (i) One of the dependents viz. wife, son, daughter, brother, sister, father, mother, nephew or niece in the order of priority will be appointed to class III or class IV post in State Government Service.
- (ii) Age relaxation by 20 years above the existing age limit would be allowed for recruitment to various posts and services.
- (iii) Government are also pleased to order that further to only one scions in respect of appointment in Government service if any, granted by Government in future to the dependents of defence personnel killed in action shall apply to all the categories mentioned above.

- 3. The Concession of appointment will be available to only one dependent who was/is wholly dependent on the serviceman concerned. In cases where more than one dependent of a deceased claim the concession, preference will be given to the near dependent in the order of priority mentioned above. Only qualified persons will be appointed on the basis of this concession.
- 4. Persons eligible for the concession will apply in the prescribed from (Annexure I) with all the required documents to prove age, qualifications, experience etc., and forward the application to the Director, Rajya Sainik Board, Trivandrum through the Secretary, Zila Sainik Board concerned. The Director Rajya Sainik Board will forward the application to Government after verification of the relevant records and satisfying himself as to the eligibility for the concession. A copy of the relevant certificate from the authority concerned to prove that the defence personnel/GREF/BSF personnel was killed/missing/disabled in action, killed due to other reasons etc., together with a certificate (Annexure II) from the Tahsildar concerned to prove the relation with and dependence on the serviceman should also be forwarded with the application.
- 5. The next-of-kin (who has revived other benefits such as balance of pay, family pension, provident fund, ex-gratia grant etc) of the personnel killed/missing etc., should apply to the Tahsildar concerned for the issue of the certificate in favor of the candidate for employment. In case any relation other than the next-of-kin applies for the certificate, the written consent of the NOK should be insisted.
- 6. In the case of permanently disabled ex-serviceman the disabled ex-serviceman himself should apply for the certificate.
- 7. In order to ensure that only one person gets the concession in respect of each service personnel killed/missing, disabled etc., the following procedure will be adopted:-

Each Tahsildar will maintain a separate register in which the names of all NOK of personnel killed/missing/disabled etc., with fill address in whose favor certificate has been issued by him will be noted. The Tahsildar will also intimate the Director, Rajya Sainik Board the name of the NOK as and when the certificate for record. The Director, Rajya Sainik Board will also in turn inform the concerned Tahsildar as and when the candidate in whose favor the certificate has been issued is advised for appointment.

8. The Director, Rajya Sainik Board will maintain a register showing the details of he defense personnel GREF/BSF personnel killed/missing/ disabled in action, killed due to other reasons etc., and the particulars of their dependents and the dependents who were appointed in Government Service under this order.
