In the G.O read as first paper above, the procedure posting of substitutes in the casual leave vacancies of part-time contingent employees in offices having only one part-time contingent employee was ordered. In the G.O. read as second paper above, the procedure for posting substitutes in such offices when the only parttime contingent employee proceeds on leave without allowances, was ordered.

2. In super session of the above orders, Government order that in offices having Only one part-time contingent employee. Substitute arrangements may be made, meeting the expenses from office contingencies when the employee proceeds on leave if any nature irrespective of the period for eligibility for leave and that the expenditure on this account will be limited to the amount that would have been admissible to the part-time contingent employee but for his/her proceeding on leave.
