## ORDER

According to the bamboo rolling rules the bamboo Claus should be out at a height of 15.cm. to 30 cm. from ground level. As such the bamboos felled from clump are full bamboos. Generally the out bamboos are converted into 3 pieces, namely the basal bamboo, middle bamboo and top bamboo.

The seignior age rate given is for the maximum length of each category ie. the basal bamboos up to 6 meters long, middle bamboo up to 9 meters long and the top bamboos up to 6 meters long.

The Conservator of Forests Vested, Kozhikode reported that during the recent inspection of the special Division Office, Nilmbur, the out Audit Party observed that the present method adopted for estimating one full bamboo is not correct.

The Chief Conservator of Forests has therefore requested Government to issue necessary orders specifying that normally a full bamboo yield three pieces. Government, are therefore pleased to order that normally a full bamboo will yield three pieces.
