To avoid this it is ordered that whenever it is proposed to sell saplings in auction, they should be brought outside the plantation, stacked and sold. Under no circumstances whatsoever saplings should be sold in plantations areas.

The Divisional Forest Officers and Conservators will please see that no more complaints are coming on this respect.
