ORDER

The 13th Finance Commission, among other things, has recommended an amount of Rs.300 crore as grant-in-aid to the State for the implementation of the scheme 'Kuttanad Development' under State Specific Grants for the period 2011-15. The grant is meant for strengthening the ecological security of the Kuttanad wetland eco-system. As per G.O read as first paper above, administrative sanction was accorded for an amount of Rs 35.43 crore for the year 2011-12.

As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Project Officer, Kuttanad Package submitted a plan of action for an amount of Rs 86.75 crore for the remaining projects under Kuttanad Development for the period 2011-15. The State Level Empowered Committee held on 06.8.2011 has approved in principle the perspective action plan for Kuttanad Development for the year 2011-15 at a cost of Rs 86.70 crores for the schemes submitted by Irrigation Department, Suchitwa Mission, Agriculture Department, District Panchayath, Alappuzha, Fisheries Department, Animal Husbandry Department, Forest Department and

Taluk Head Quarters Hospital, Pulinkunnu, subject to detailed scrutiny of components at appropriate levels.

Government, after having examined the matter in detail, are pleased to accord administrative sanction for implementation of the 13th FC grant-in-aid of Kuttanad Development at a cost of Rs 86.70 crore, during the period of 2011-15 with an annual outlay of Rs 26.50 crore for the financial year 2011-12. The total annual outlay of Rs 61.91 crores, including Rs 35.43 crore sanctioned as per the G.O read as first paper above is subject to the following conditions;

- i) The actual expenditure should be limited to the award amount
- ii) Tender excess will not be allowed
- iii) Time overrun and cost overrun shall be avoided.
- iv) The manpower has to be kept at absolute minimum and all appointments shall be on contract basis. The appointments thus made shall cease to exist after the award period.
- v) For projects involving construction, completion certificate duly signed by the competent authority should be furnished.

The implementing Departments and agencies will furnish the progress report on the implementation of the scheme on each quarter to the Government and will ensure that the project will be completed within the stipulated time. The expenditure in this respect will be met by debit to the head of account '2401-00-800-32(P)' in the current year's Budget Estimates.

The component wise and yearwise details of the scheme are shown in the annexure appended to this order.
