ORDER

In the G.O second read, it has been provided that deposits of ‘retention money’ of contractors shall be made only with the “Treasury Savings Bank” and the provisions in Kerala Public Works Account Code have been suitably amended. The question whether the security deposits of Public Works and Public Health Engineering contractor may likewise be made compulsory in the Treasury Savings Bank have been engaging the attention of Government for sometime past and they are pleased to order that henceforth investment in Treasury Savings Bank will alone be treated as acceptable form of security for works undertaken by the Public Works and Public Health Engineering contractors.

2. Necessary amendment to the Public Works Account Code will issue separately.
