It has been brought to the notice of the undersigned that contract agreements for maramathu works executed by the Divisional Forest Officers contain several discrepancies in terms conditions and rates of recoveries and are not scrutinized by the conservators. This is fair form satisfactory Agreements should be foul proof and flawless in order to avoid lose to Government and avoid unnecessary claims by contractors. To serve this object is necessary. The Conservators of Forests are there fore directed to get copies of all agreements executed by Divisional Forest Officers under their and to scrutinise them carefully and get defects if any rectified immediately. This does and in any way impair the present authority of the Divisional Forest Officers to execute the agreements on behalf of Government within their competency.
