Sub:- Instructions regarding sale of thondy timber and Firewood.

Ref:- Malayattur D.F.O.'s No.M2.11815/73 18-10-'73.

It is observed that thondy logs and firewood are sold at site and that too, without adequate publicity and furnishing the full details of thondy to be sold. Before selling valuable thondy at site, the possibility of working down such thondy to a central place economically should be examined at first. If such work is found uneconomical size auction may be reported to, taking adequate precautionary measures to prevent any malpractice. When valuable thondy timbers are sold, full details of the produce should be given in the notification so as to attract bidders. Thondy timbers worked down to depots should be sold on the day of auction sale of timber at the concerned Depot. Receipt of this Circular order should be acknowledged.
