It has come to the notice of the Government that a number of vehicles which are ripe for condemnation and unserviceable spare parts are kept idle in various department/offices and that the departments concerned do not take timely action for the disposal of those items. This results in great loss to the state exchequer.

The heads of departments are, therefore, instructed to take stock of such articles and make necessary proposals for condemnation in accordance with the Government Order cited and the relevant provisions in the Kerala Financial code Volume – I, within one month positively.
