Sub; Budget- Regularization of additional expenditure- Instructions issued.

Ref ; Letter No. Rep.III /53-2/ Excess/ 77-78 / 110 dated 11-8-1981 from the Accountant General, Kerala.

According to para 95 (3) of the Kerala Budget Manual, additional expenditure authorized there under has to be regularized in time either by reappropriation or by before the close of the financial year concerned. The Supplementary Grant Accountant General, Kerala in his letter cited, has pointed out a case relating to the head of account "726-O- 3 loans to the Plantation Corporation of Kerala Limited" in which the Director of Agriculture had not taken steps in time to regularize the additional amount of RS.5 Lakhs authorized under para 95 (3) OF the Kerala Budget Manual, for payment of loan to the Plantation Corporation of Kerala Limited, resulting in an uncovered excess of RS2.57 Lakhs. The excess had to be taken up with the Public Accounts Committee for regularization under Article 205 of the Constitution. As such instances are to be avoided, all the Controlling Officers are requested t o ensure that additional funds authorized under para 95 (3) of the Kerala Budget Manual are regularized during the same financial year itself either reappropriation or by Supplementary Grant.
