ORDER

With a view to effecting economy in public expenditure Government have in their order read above, imposed certain restrictions regarding the incurring of expenditure during the current financial year. Representations have since been made by some Departments to exempt them from those restrictions, especially those relating to 'Travelling Allowance', Contingencies and other charges.

- 2. Government regret that it is not possible to agree to any general or absolute exemption being given to any particular department from the restrictions imposed by G.O.(P)426/65/Fin. Dated 8-11-1965. It is, however, felt that at this stage of the financial year the curtailment of expenditure under "Contingencies" and "Other Charges" (non-plan) to 95% of the budgeted provision and the ban on reappropriation of funds for "Travelling Allowance", "Contingencies" and "other charges" have to be relaxed to some extent.
- 3. Accordingly the restrictions imposed by G.O(P)426/65/Fin. Dated 8-11-1965 are relaxed to enable the incurring of expenditure under 'Travelling Allowance', 'Contingencies' and 'Other charges' up to the level indicated in the revised estimates for 1965-66 as approved by Government. Such re-appropriations as are warranted by these revised estimates will also be permitted subject to the provisions in the Budget Manual.
