ORDER

In the G.O. cited, Government ordered certain measures for 1972-73 for bringing about maximum economy in expenditure. Of these, the following measures were only for a period of 3 months from 15-05-1972.

- (i) Ban on fresh recruitments (para 2 of the G.O)
- (ii) Restrictions on incurring expenditure on new works (para 7 of the G.O.)
- (iii) Restrictions on immediate payments (para 12 of the G.O.)

2. Government order that the above short-term measures will be continued for a further period of three months from 15-08-72. The ban on fresh recruitment will not, however, apply to replacement of provisional hands by the Public Service Commission recruits as and when they become available, as already clarified in Circular No.53/72/Fin date d5-7-1972 (appended).

3. The other measures mentioned in the G.O. cited will, however, continue to be in force throughout the financial year 1972-73.
