**CIRCULAR**

Dated, Trivandrum, 18<sup>th</sup> October, 1982.

Sub:- Economy – Economy in Government expenditure – Measures to be adopted in the current five year plan (1980-85) – Further directions – Issued

With a view to maximize the resources available for the current Five Year Plan and to eliminate avoidable expenditure, Government have issued economy orders from time to time and have directed the Departments of the Secretariat, Heads of Departments and other Controlling Officers to strictly follow the orders. It is noticed that there has been laxity in observing restrictions imposed in the above orders with the result that administrative expenses are on the increase. The Subject Committee-VIII Economic Affairs (1982-84), in its first report, has recommended that strict economy measures should be enforced to curtail administrative expenses.

2. Having considered the above recommendation of the subject Committee, Government hereby direct that the Departments of the Secretariat and Heads of Departments and Offices will ensure that the orders issued in the G.O.(P)708/80/Fin. Dated 4-10-1980 are scrupulously followed.
