## **ORDER**

In G.O.(P) No.763/82/Fin. Dated 14-12-1982 it was ordered, among other things, that in the case of officers drawing a pay of less than Rs.1500 p.m. special mileage will not be allowed under any circumstances. Government hereby clarify that the officers drawing a pay of less than Rs.1500 mentioned above do not include those belonging to All India Services, non0 All India Services Officers holding posts borne on the carde of All Indian Services, Heads of Departments etc., who are eligible for drawal of Special mileage, irrespective of the pay drawn by them as per Rule I Part II Kerala Service Rules and the nots given there under.
