

Copy of Circular No.B5-9823/60 dated 20-6-61 from the Chief Conservator of Forests

Sub:- Schedule of Rates – Exceeding of

Several reports are being received from the Conservators to the effect that the rates sanctioned in the schedule of Rates are quite inadequate and that a higher rate is necessary for the conduct of work. In some cases, it is seen that the Conservators themselves have sanctioned higher rates. Both Government and the Accountant General are taking strong exception to such deviations without sanction from competent authorities.

2. The schedule of rates are fixed with due deference to the existing labour conditions. If in any case, the rates are found to be unworkably low, it is up to the Conservators to get the rates refixed urgently by the competent authority. Any Officer sanctioning a rate higher than that provided in the schedule without proper sanction, does so at his risk and will have to bear the consequences.
