ORDER

Sanction is accorded prescribing the following terms and conditions of appointment of officers on deputation to the Command Area Development Authority, Kerala.

a. The deputation will be for the period ordered.
b. The deputation will begin from the date of relief of the Of ficer and will terminate on the date of rejoining duty in the state Service.

c. The Officer will be allowed to draw usual pay and allowance the Officer would have drawn in the parent department and deputation allowances admissible from time to time.

d. The Officer will be paid travelling allowances as per Kerala Service Rules.

The Officerwill be Entitl allowed joining time and transit pay and allowances as per rules of the State Government.

- f. The Officer will be entitled tomedical facilities in accordance with the rules applicable to the State Government employees.
- Service Rules. The Officer will be governed by the leave rules in Kerala
 - h. The medical concessions to the officers and to Officer's family and eudcational concession to Officer's children will be allowed on a scale not less favourable than that under State Government.
 - i. The foreign employer should calculate the rate of pension contribution payable as per Rule 146 Part-I Kerala Service Ruoes without waiting for intimation from the Department and yearly remittance of contribution should be made as per orders issued from the Government from time to time.

The foreign employer will also pay the leave salary charges in respect of any special disability leave granted on account of a disability incurred in and through foreign service eventhough such a disability manifests itself after the termination of foreign service. The entire expenditure in respect of any compensatory allowances for periods of leave in or at the end of foreign service should be borne by the foreign employer. If the deputationist is a subscriber to the Family Benefit scheme, the Officer will remit the subscription promptly to the scheme by money order at his cost to the concerned The Officer will not be officers in the parent department. permitted later to pay the arrears in lump. Failure to remit the subscription as above will make the deputationist to be treated as a 'drop out' in which case the subscriber will no t be entitled to the refund of even the amount already depostted by the subscriber to the scheme if there is any default from subscriber's fault for any month other than the period on leave without allowances. The Officer (on deputation to foreign service) himself should, without delay, communicate a copy of the order sanctioning deputation to the Accountant General (Accounts and Entitlem . ments)/(Audit), Kerala and take his instructions as to the Officer to whom he is to account for the contribution and report the following to the latter Officer as required under Rule 145, Part-I, Kerala Service Rules: i. the time and date of transfer of charge when proceeding on, while in, and on return from foreign service, ii . particulars regarding his pay in foreign service, iii. leave taken by him iv. postal address v. other information required.
n. In respect of any matter not specifically covered by the above conditions, the relevant provisions in Chapter XI, Part-I Kerala Service Rules will apply. The Government also order that the proposals for deputation of officers to the foreigns ervice in the Command Area Development Authority and the orders sanctioning such proposals should invariably contain information on the following in a separate statement as per Government decision under Rule 144 Part-I Kerala Service Rules. i. Name of the Government servant ii . Date of birth iii. To whom lent iv. Official designation (Post held substantively before transfer). Scale of may of the post in Govt. service held substantively by the Officer. Head of account to which pay has debitable before vi. transfer.
