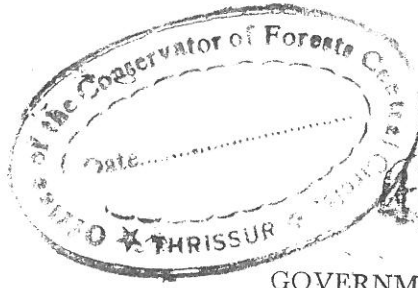

**ORDER**

As per the Government Order read above, house rent allowance and city compensatory allowance are admissible during periods of leave with allowances upto the first 180 days. Government Order that hill tract allowance, also being a compensatory allowance based on the place of duty, is admissible upto the first 180 days, during periods of leave with allowances. This order will take effect retrospectively from 25-7-1995.
