## ORDER

In Partial modification of the provisions in Rule 91 in Part I of the K.S.R., the Government are pleased to order as follows:-

- 1. The minimum service required to render an officiating or temporary officer in a non-technical Department eligible for leave for higher studies is reduced to two years from five years.
- 2. The concessions available to officiating or temporary Medical Officers under the latter part of the Rule are extended to technical officers of other technical Departments like Engineering, Veterinary and Agriculture.
- 3. Finance Department will take steps to amend the rule accordingly.
