NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Art.309 of the constitution of India the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules published under notification No.Fin.CR.57702/59/10-11-1959, namely:-

The notes under Rules 93, part I of the said rules shall be numbered as (1) and the following shall be added as note (2) after note(1) as so numbered.

"For the purpose of rule 92 and 93 the leave salary of an Officer who is in permanent employ and who has been continuously officiating another post for more than three years at the time he proceeds on Leave, shall be calculated as if he were the substantive holder of the post in which he was so officiating or in which he would have so officiated out for his officiating appointment in an equivalent or still higher post."
