O R D E R

With the introduction of the Panchayat Raj System in the State, the three-tier Panchayat Raj Institutions have come into existence. Government have transferred several schemes for the implementation benefitting scheduled castes and scheduled tribes also. However, there are certain schemes which have not been transferred to the Panchayat Raj Institutions which should be formulated taking into consideration the local conditions. Government have to ensure that the schemes aimed at the upliftment of the SC/ST people are benefited only to the SC/ST people. In the past schemes benefitting SC/ST people were approved by the District Level Working Group. With the introduction of the Panchayat Raj System, the District Level Working Group has ceased to exist. In the circumstances, Government are pleased to constitute the District Level Committee for SC/ST Development in each District with the following members:

1. President, District Panchayat - Chairperson
2. District Collector - Member Secretary
3. District Planning Officer - Member
4. SC/ST MLAs in the District - Members
5. Chairman, Welfare Standing Committee of District panchayat - Member
6. Three social workers
7. belonging to SC/ST from the District to be nominated by Government - Members
8. District Scheduled Caste Development Officer - Member
9. Project Officer ITDP (Tribal Development Officer) - Member
10. Convenor of the District Level banker's Committee - Member

12. The Assistant General Manager, NABARD - Member
13. The District Officer of the following Departments - Members

The functions of the committee will mainly be the following:

- i. Clearing of the Schemes under SCP/TSP and SCA to SCP/SCA to TSP (Except those schemes transferred to Local Bodies)
- ii. Monitoring and review of all the schemes including those implemented by the local bodies.

The financial power of this committee will be Rs.25 lakhs per scheme.
