NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the K.S.R. published under Notification No. Fin. (CR) 57702/59 dated 10-11-1959 namely :-

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules after Rule 92(ii) Part I, the following shall be added as a note, namely:-

“Note :- The words “the twelve complete months preceding the month in which the leave commences” occurring in the above rule should be interpreted literally. Thus, an officer who was on leave from 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 1959 to 26<sup>th</sup> October, 1959 inclusive is granted leave from 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 1960. His average pay should be calculated on the pay earned for the periods 1<sup>st</sup> March, 1959 to 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 1959 and 27<sup>th</sup> October 1959 to 29<sup>th</sup> February, 1960. If however an officer happens to have been on leave for more than 12 months immediately preceding the month in which the leave is taken, then the average should be taken of the monthly pay earned during the 12 complete months immediately preceding the month in which the previous leave commenced.

Any period of joining time taken under rule 125(b) during the preceding 12 months should be ignored in calculating average pay as no pay is drawn in respect of such joining time.

Example:- A Gazetted Officer who was on leave from 14<sup>th</sup> April, 1960 to 6<sup>th</sup> May 1960 inclusive granted leave from 12<sup>th</sup> August 1960. In order to arrive at his average pay the total pay earned for the periods of duty viz., from 1<sup>st</sup> August, 1959 to 13<sup>th</sup> April, 1960 and

from 7<sup>th</sup> mammy. 1960 to 31<sup>st</sup> July 1960, should be divided by 8 plus 13/30 plus 25/31 plus 2= 10453/930 months, the fractions 13/30 and 25/31 representations period of duty in terms of months in April, and May, 1960 respectively. Where X is the total pay earned by duty from Ist August 1939 to 13<sup>th</sup> April, 1960 and from 6<sup>th</sup> May. 1960 to 31<sup>st</sup> July 1960, the average pay is equal to  $930x/10433$ ,”
