ORDER

As per rule 23 (a) Part I Kerala Service Rules an officer shall begin to draw the pay and allowances attached to his tenure of a post with effect from the date he assumes the duties of that post. So normally the claim for the monetary benefit is from the date of assumption of charge in the promotion post. Further Rule 23 (c) provides that promotion which do not involve change of duties shall have effect from the date of occurance of vacancy. Hence a vacant post is a pre-requisite for ordering provisional or regular promotion. But notional promotions are ordered under exigencies of service owing to retrospective revision of seniority and also based on court directions, without ascertaining whether there is sufficient number of vacancies to order promotion. In such cases back arrears are not permissible.

Several proposals are being received requesting for the sanction of back arrears to notional promotion. In order to maintain a consistant stand in accordance with the prevailing rules, Government wish to clarify that back arrears are not admissible for notional promotion.
