In the G.O cited, the Government sanctioned house rent allowance at the following rates to all the Non-Gazetted Officers of the State, in view of the high cost of living.

(i) For officers drawing a pay not exceeding Rs. 150 per mensem ...

(ii) For other N G Os.

Rs.7. p.m.

Representations have since been received for increasing the rates of house rent allowance. The Government have considered the question and are pleased to order that in the case of all those Government servants to whom the existing rate of Rs. 5 per mensem is applicable, the rate of house rent allowance will be raised to Rs.7p.m.with effect from1stApril, 1962. Accordingly all the Non-Gazetted Officers will draw the allowance at a uniform rate of Rs.7 p.m. with effect from 1st April, 1962.
