ORDER

In the G.Os. read as 1st and 2nd papers above, Government orders that the allowance sanctioned to the Typists and Stenographers and to the personal staff of Ministers will be treated as Special pay under Appendix IV, Part 1 Kerala Service Rules with effect from 1-11-1959.

2. In the Circular 3rd cited, it was clarified that the special pay falling under Classes I and II of Appx. IV will count as pay for purposes of calculation of Dearness allowance.
3. It has now been brought to the notice of Government that these orders have adversely affected some officers resulting in a reduction in their total emoluments. An illustration is given below:

This reduction of Rs. 7 in the total emoluments has been caused in this case because the officer is not eligible for the higher rate of special Dearness allowance.

4. Government consider that the change of nomenclature of certain allowances to special pay should not adversely affect the officers concerned by causing a reduction in their total emoluments and therefore order that in respect of those officers affected by the orders read above.
- (i) the recovery for the period from 1-11-1959 till 10-3-1961 of the amounts, if any which has proved to be excess drawal consequent on the application of the orders read above, already drawn shall be waived; and
 - (ii) that an amount equal to the actual drop in their total emoluments as on 9-3-1961 will be allowed as personal allowance to be absorbed in future increases of pay, special pay or dearness allowance.
