# AMENDMENT C. S. No.22/61/Dated 11-7-1961

In Appendix IV of the said rules. in the entries under the heading "clause VI-Miscellaneous"-

- (1) after item (e), the following item shall be inserted as item (f) and the existing item (f) shall be relettered as item (g), namely:-
  - "(f) allowances granted to officers deputed for training"
- (2) The following Not shall be added at the end, namely:-

"Note:- In cases where the period of training exceeds three months, compensatory allowance may be granted to officers deputed for training outside the State at the discretion of Government in consideration of the high cost of living in the place of training."
