ORDER

Government, while sanctioned a Conveyance Allowance of Rs. 50 per month to the physically handicapped Government employees as per order first read above have specified that in the case of blind employees, the allowance will be admissible on the recommendations of the Head of the Ophthalmologic Departments of a Government Civil Hospital. The above orders are however applicable only to totally blind employees.

2. Government are now pleased to order that Government servants having vision less than 3/60 or field vision less 10 in both eyes, will also be eligible for the grant of the conveyance allowance in terms of the G.O. read above. The revised orders will take effect from the date date of issue in the case of employees already in service. For those who develop the disability at a future date, the relevant date of eligibility will be the date of receipt of the recommendation of the competent medical authority by the Head of the Department.
