ORDER

It has come to the notice of the Government that a section of the Government employees have participated in the ‘Dharna’ on 10-7-1981 in response to the call given by the All Kerala Typists and Stenographers’ Association.

2. According to the standing orders, read above, the leave applied for by the employees for participating in the “Dharna” should be refused. Government order that the leave applied for by the Government’s employees on 10-7-1981 to participate in the “Dharna” be refused and their unauthorized absence on that day be treated as “Dies-non” under Rule 14-A, Part I, Kerala Service Rules. All the cases settled otherwise will be reopened and disposed of on the basis of these orders. If the duration of unauthorized absence is for 3 hours and less half-a-day’s pay cut will be effected and if it exceeds 3 hours, the whole day’s payment will be disallowed.

3. The Drawing and Disbursing officers concerned will make necessary arrangements to effect the pay cut from the pay and allowances of the employees concerned consequent on these orders and necessary entries be made in the Service Books of the concerned employees.
