ORDER

On a scheme sponsored by the Government of India to increase the emoluments of low paid employees, Government sanctioned in the G.O. first cited Special Dearness allowance to low-paid employees of Government, Local Bodies etc at the rates mentioned there in. A further increase in the Special Dearness Allowance sanctioned to low paid employees of Government in the G.O. second cited, was extended to he low paid employees of the Local Bodies also in the G.O. third cited. During the second plan period assistance from the Government of India was received for implementing the scheme, and the State Government was giving assistance to Local Bodies for meeting a part of the expenditure incurred for payment of Special Dearness allowance to their employees. The Central assistance for the scheme having been stopped from 1961-62 the question arose whether the Local Bodies would be able to continue payment of Special Dearness allowance to their employees meeting the expenditure from their own funds, and if not whether the State should give assistance to them for the continued payment of Special Dearness allowance and if so to what extent

Having considered the present financial position of the Local Bodies, and also the other aspects of the question, Government are pleased to order that assistance for the continued payment of Special Dearness allowance to their employees will be given to Local Bodies at present rate for 1961-62 and at reduced rates thereafter as shown below so that the end of five years the assistance is completely withdrawn.
