ORDER

In the G.O. first read above the Government have ordered that the Additional First Class Magistrate’s Court Chalakudy be shifted from the present rented building to “pottery Bungalow’ Chalakudy”. The Chief Engineer (Buildings and Roads) has reported in his letter dated 8-6-1962 second read above that the Pottery Bungalow is quite inadequate for housing the court that the construction of the new building to house the court can be completed by the end of December 1962 and that the court may continue to be housed in the present rented building till the completion of the new building. The High Court has endorsed the views of the Chief Engineer (Buildings and Roads). In the circumstances stated the Government direct that the Additional First Class Magistrate’s Court Chalakudy will continue to be housed in the present rented building till the end of December 1962 or the completion of the new building whichever is earlier after which period the court will be shifted to the newly constructed building. The orders issued in the G.O. first read above are cancelled.
