ORDER

In the G.O. read above, it was ordered that in respect of timber the value of which had been fully paid and which were remaining unremoved after the period provided for in the sale notice, ground rent at twice the rate leviable for the second month would be levied, and that if the timber remained in the depot for six months from the date of sale, the Divisional Forest Officers should take immediate steps to reauction the timber. A doubt has been raised about the rate of ground rent to be levied for timbers lying unremoved after six months of sale. Government order that for period in excess of six months three times the rate leviable for the first month will be levied.

The Chief Conservator of Forests is informed that this order will take effect from the date of issue and will not have retrospective effect.
