ORDER

Government order that the stay orders regarding the recovery of amounts of Rs.20,000 and above due from parties to Government as arrears of principal and interest will be vacated with immediate effect. Individual cases covered by the above orders will, however, he reviewed by a Committee of Senior Officers of Revenue, Finance and Taxes Departments. The cases involving extreme hardship like those of individuals who have gone out of business and who lack reasonable assets to be proceeded against should be put up to the Ministers concerned for orders with the recommendations of the Committee as to whether any installment concession, on payment of a substantial initial amount, should be given.
