In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

Amendment

C.S.No. 40/63.

Dated 28th October 1963

In Part I of the said rules, for rule 131 the following rule shall be substituted namely:-

“131, If a Government servant takes leave while in transit from one post to another, the period which has elapsed since he handed over charge of his old post must be included in his leave. On the expiry of the leave, the Government servant may be allowed normal joining time”.
