ORDER

The question of revising the pay scales and the dearness allowance of the Government employees which was urged by the various service associations has been under the consideration of the Government for some tome now. While Government consider that any basic revision of pay scales or dearness allowance has to be gone into in detail by a Pay Commission, they feel that interim relief should be granted to Government employees in the lower pay groups in view of the rise in the cost of living.

The Government are accordingly pleased to order an ad hoc increase in the dearness allowance of Government servants drawing a basic pay not exceeding Rs. 500/- per men sum, on the following scale with effect from 1st October 1964.

(Basic pay' excludes dearness pay but includes special pay and other emoluments which under the existing orders are deemed part of pay for purpose of calculating the rate of dearness allowance)

The above increase will be an ad hoc addition to the element of "Dearness allowance" without affecting the rates of dearness pay under the existing orders.

The above increase will apply to full time Government employees borne on contingent and work charged establishments also.
