Read:- Letter No O&M.33822/65 dated 10-11-1965 from the Director of Health Services.

O R D E R

1. The rules regarding special casual leave to Government servants are given in Section II of Appendix VII, Kerala Service Rules. It is provided in the last paragraph of this Section that the power of granting special casual leave under these orders will be exercised by Heads of Departments in the case of Officers under their administrative control, and that in the case of Heads of Departments partaking in sporting events, special casual leave will be granted by Government.

2. The Director of Health Services, in his letter read above, has stated that it will be more convenient if the power now exercised by Heads of Departments is delegated to the District Officers so as to avoid delay in the disposal of such cases.

3. After examining the question in detail, Government are pleased to order that the power now exercised by Heads of Departments in this regard may be exercised by regional and district officers also, in the case of officers under their administrative control.

4. Necessary amendment to the Kerala Service Rules will be issued separately.
