ORDER

The Director of Health Services has raised the question of extending the benefit of joining time to contingent employees on transfer from one station to another. Government have examined the various aspects of the question and are pleased to issue the following orders:---

Normally the Contingent employees shall not be transferred as no public interest is involved in their transfer. Their transfer by way of punitive measure or from institutions treating contagious diseases cannot be considered to be in the public interests. If, for any reason, the contingent employees are transferred from one station to another, they may be allowed the minimum joining time (i.e.) actual journey time. Where such transfers cannot be proved to be in the public interests no joining-time pay (transit pay) or T.A. for the journeys involved will be allowable.
