In paragraph 3 (iv) of the G.O. cited, it has been ordered that the grant of leave to re-employed officers will be governed by the rules in Appendix VIII of the Kerala Service Rules in all cases. With a view to codifying these orders in the Kerala Service Rules, Government are pleased to issue the following notification:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

AMENDMENT

c.s.No.130/67

In Part I of the said rules, in Note I under rule 63, for the second sentence, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“In such cases, the service of the re-employed pensioner should be regarded as temporary and his leave during the period of re-employment regulated by the rules in Appendix VIII”.
