Sub:-Leave-Surrendered leave in or at the end of deputation to foreign service-Instructions-Issued.

According to Note I under Rule 147, Part I, Kerala Service Rules, the foreign employer has to meet the entire expenditure in respect of any compensatory allowance for periods of leave in or at the end of the foreign service and a condition to this effect is incorporated in all cases of deputation to foreign service sanctioned. Similarly the difference between the amount of leave salary that would have been admissible to the officer had he remained in Government service and the amount of leave salary calculated on the pay drawn in foreign service shall be recoverable from the foreign employer. The question has been raised whether, when officers deputed to foreign service surrender earned leave, compensatory allowance, the difference in leave salary and the leave salary contributions for the period on leave surrendered in or at the end of foreign service should also be recovered from the foreign employer.

Government after having examined the question, hereby clarify that the difference in leave salary and compensatory allowances for the periods of earned leave surrendered in or at the end of foreign service shall be met by the foreign employer. The leave salary contribution for the periods of leave surrendered shall also be recoverable from the foreign employer.
