

Copy of Chief Conservator's letter No. PU(3) 47407/76 dt.6/14.8.76 addressed to the Conservator of Forests, Trichur, etc

Sub :- Supply of Karanjily logs to Government of India consignees a withdrawal 1st selection extended to plywood firm-reg-

Species Karanjily(Gurjan) is one of the accepted species for supply to Government of India and the present rates payable for the species are :-

120-150 x3m and up	Rs500/-per cum
150 cm and up - do	Rs500/- per cum.

About 3000 cum of hardwood have to be supplied to the various consignees of railway before 31-10-76. For this intensive and extensive selection of hardwood have to be made, allotted and dispatched so as to honor the commitments.

It is seen Karanjaly logs are allowed to be selected by the quota holders especially by the Travancore Plywood Limited direct from the regular supply coupes. The rate paid by the firms is very low when compared to the rates paid by the Government of India.

It is therefore here by ordered that first preference should be given for selection of Karanjily species for Government of India supply at the time of conversion and registration and such timber should be delivered with out delay at the specified depot. Where from selection will be made by the Forest Utilization Officer or Asst. Utilization Officer. At the time of registering of the logs a chistle mark 'R' should also be furnished by the registering officers in the registering list.

"Certified that all the logs qualified for selection for Government of India supply have been earmarked and registered separately and arranged to be transported to the Government Supply depot with least delay."

Government of India Quality species Karanjily of and above 120cm in midgirth from all defects is sound, more or less cylindrical logs.

A list of logs thus registered and name of depot where the stock is to be delivered should be forwarded to the Forest Utilization Officer as soon as the registering is over. Any failure to comply with this instruction will be seriously dealt with. Necessary urgent instructions should be issued to the Range Officers and Depot Officers to the above effect. This order is not applicable to mallabham coupes given to quota holders.
