ORDER

In the G.O. read above, orders have been issued, among others granting ad-hoc increase in emoluments to all full time Government employees at the rates shown therein with effect from January 1.1971 it was also ordered that the ad-hoc increase will not be taken into account for any other allowance that may be admissible on the basis of pay and that it will not count for purpose of pension etc.

2. A question has been raised whether the state Government employees on deputation to Central Government, other State Governments or to foreign Service are entitled to ad-hoc increase in emoluments. Government have examined the matter and are pleased to clarify that the State Government officers on deputation to foreign service with state scales of pay, will also be entitled to the benefit of ad-hoc increase in emoluments with effect from January 1, 1971.
