

Copy of Government letter No.6509/F3/69/AD dated 11.7.69 from the secretary to Government, Agriculture (forest) Department to the Chief Conservator of Forests, and Trivandrum.

Sub:- Forests – Transport of bamboos in lorries by several individuals regarding.

Ref:- Your letter No.C5/17969/68 dt. 24/27-1-69.

I am to inform you that the intention of Government to issue passes to bonafide consumers only for 20 bamboos is to prevent transporting the material illegally to public or private markets. Government, therefore, agree that some restriction is quite necessary regarding the mode of conveyance. The bonafide consumers who are from adjoining villages may be allowed to transport bamboos collected on passes by cartload or river raft and not by lorry.
