**ORDER**

Under item 35 of the orders issued in the G.O. read above the Chief Conservator of Forests has been interalia delegated with full powers for elimination of thondy articles which are not economical. Vehicles used for illegal transport of forest produces are confiscated under rule 61 A of the Forest Act. Such vehicles have to be disposed of immediately after finalization of the cases by the Courts concerned. At present orders on the disposal of the such vehicles are issued by the Government. This causes delay.

Government are therefore pleased to order that the principal chief Conservator of Forests may sanction the disposal of vehicles confiscated under rule 61 A of the Forest Act, as these vehicles too form part of the thondy in the case.
