## **ORDER**

The existing qualifications, method of appointment etc for the post of Attenders on Rs.35-60 in the Engineering Colleges, Junior Technical Schools and Polytechnics are those prescribed in Government orders read as 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and third paper above. The only method of appointment now prescribed for the post is transfer from among the three categories of posts in the last grade service specified in the Government order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above. The Director of Technical Education has reported in his letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above that only very few candidates with the prescribed qualifications are available in the Department for appointment as Attenders, and that candidates with the required experience in Laboratories and workshops may not be available for transfer from other Departments. This has caused difficulties in filling up the posts of Attenders in Polytechnics. The Director of Technical Education has, therefore recommended that provision may be made for direct Recruitment to the post of attenders on Rs.35-60 in the Polytechnics. The Government consider that provision for direct recruitment is necessary for the posts in Junior Technical Schools and Engineering Colleges also.

2. In the circumstances, Government in consultation with the Kerala Public Service Commission and in partial modification of the Government orders read as 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> papers above, are pleased to order that direct recruitment, in the absence of qualified candidates for transfer, will also be an alternative method of appointment to the post of Attenders performing technical schools and Polytechnics the minimum and maximum age limits for direct recruitment being 19 years and 25 years respectively with the usual relaxation for scheduled castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes.
