**ORDER**

At the 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Tourist Development Council held at Hyderabad, the Council accepted the suggestion that there should be discrimination between Indian and foreign hunters regarding levy of uniform fees for reservation of shooting blocks and game licenses for Indian as well as foreign hunters.

2. The Chief Conservator of Forests has reported that there is no difference in shooting license fee for foreigners and local citizens in this State and that the following are the current rates for shooting license in Kerala (vide G.O.MS.767/Agri. dated 28-7-59).

3. The Chief Conservator of Forests has recommended that the above rates may be enhanced by 50% uniformly, applicable both to foreign and local shikaries.
4. Government accept the proposal of the Chief Conservator of Forests and order accordingly. A deposit of Rs.150/- (instead of Rs.100/-) will be insisted on every license whether Big of small game. The G.O. read as first paper stands modified to this extent also.
