ORDER

In the G.O. read above sanction was accorded for the employment of four gunmen for the protection of the two survey parties engaged in survey of unsurveyed boundary between Quilon and Kottayam Districts. Since the Chief Conservator of Forests has pointed out the possibility of disturbance to the Wild Life dur to the presence of the professional gunmen there the Board of Revenue has suggested that instead of employing two gunmen at the rate of Rs.5/- each per day one Guard at the rate of Rs.4/- and 2 hillmen at the rate of Rs.3/- each per day may be attached with each survey party.

In modification of orders in G.O. read above sanctioned is accorded for the employment of one Guard at the rate of Rs.4/- and two hillmen at the rate of Rs.3/- each per day for each survey party engaged in the survey of new boundary between Quilon and Kottayam Districts. The Chief Conservator of Forests will make necessary arrangements for providing the services of the Guards and hillmen to the survey party.
