

Memorandum No.69781/F2/63-4 dated 10-12-1963 from Agriculture Department (Forest) Trivandrum.

Sub:- Forests – Supply of timber to the Standard Furniture Company from Nemea Division – regarding.

Ref:- From the Chief Conservator of Forests D.O. letter No.C4-10476/63 dated 29-11-1963.

Normally there is no necessity for reconsideration and the Government orders will have to stand. But because of the awkward situation created by the execution of an agreement unwarranted under the circumstances the Government are forced though reluctantly to show some relaxation in the matter of allotment of softwood to the above firm. Therefore in modification of the Government orders of even number dated 29-11-1963 50% of the balance quota for this year to the Standard Furniture Company will be supplied from the Nemmara area and the balance 50% from the Kakki area.

The Chief Conservator of Forests is informed that there is no question of any further reconsideration and any further action on his part should be strictly in accordance with this.
